Friday	9	Pray for those who have no friends
Saturday	10	Pray that soon, everyone in the world will receive the vaccine
Sunday	11	Pray that our eyes and hearts will be opened to injustices and that we will be bolder in our stand against it
Monday	12	Pray for our farming and fishing industries
Tuesday	13	Pray that all who face traumas and suffering will find God's beauty in surprising places
Wednesday	14	Pray that we will seek silence to alert and open us to God's stirring presence
Thursday	15	We give thanks for all who pray for the suffering world and that we will have the fortitude to join them

Friday	16	Pray to find opportunities for joy and laughter
Saturday	17	Pray for a cleaner, kinder world
Sunday	18	Pray for peace in our hearts and that we will learn to forgive
Monday	19	Pray to find our place in creation by gently caring for all who inhabit it with us
