Saturday	7th.	That we will be rid of all bitterness and resentment.
Sunday	8th.	Remembrance Day: For all who die or are wounded through war.
Monday	9th.	For all who suffer from Dementia and their carers.
Tuesday	10th.	Give thanks for those who work to right what is wrong.
Wednesday	11th.	For all prisoners and prison officers.
Thursday	12th.	That the homeless will find shelter this winter.
Friday	13th.	For all victims of human trafficking.
Saturday	14th.	For those who suffer from mental and emotional anguish.
Sunday	15th.	For Jeff and our church wardens, Barbara and Judy.
Monday	16th.	Give thanks for all who have supported us in the past year.
Tuesday	17th.	For those in the world unable to get any medical help.
Wednesday	18th.	For those suffering from an addiction.
Thursday	19th.	We give thanks for our beautiful world.
Friday	20th.	For all victims of our world's mistakes and evils.
Saturday	21st.	For those who have given up hope.
Sunday	22nd.	That we will take time to live in the present moment.
Monday	23rd.	For those who do the unpleasant mucky jobs.
Tuesday	24th.	For those who daily risk their lives in their work.
Wednesday	25th.	For all who have lost a child.
