| Saturday | 6 | For those who are dying alone and are fearful |
| Sunday | 7 | For those struggling with broken relationships |
| Monday | 8 | For people of the world living in extreme poverty and hardship |
| Tuesday | 9 | For the sick in mind, body and spirit, that they may know God's power to heal |
| Wednesday | 10 | Give thanks for those who provide us with local services and pray that they will be kept safe |
| Thursday | 11 | For all who are contemplating suicide, that they will find a glimmer of hope to carry on living |
| Friday | 12 | For all who help the distressed, homeless and the needy |
| Saturday | 13 | That the Holy Spirit will help us to confess our sins and bring us the peace of forgiveness |
